Содержание

Работа состоит из 7 заданий разной сложности.

Задание 1. *Чтение и интерпретация цитаты*

Вам будет предложена цитата. Прочитайте её вслух, а затем объясните, как вы понимаете её смысл. Приведите примеры или рассуждения, подтверждающие вашу точку зрения.

Задание 2. *Ответ на личные вопросы*

Ответьте на несколько вопросов, касающихся вашей жизни, интересов, опыта и мнения. Постарайтесь давать развёрнутые и содержательные ответы.

Задание 3. *Сравнение двух изображений*

Опишите и сравните две картинки, объединённые общей темой. Обратите внимание на сходства и различия, а также выразите своё отношение к изображённой ситуации.

Задание 4. *Описание одной картинки с опорой на фразы*

Опишите предложенное изображение, используя ключевые фразы и выражения. Постарайтесь раскрыть, что происходит на картинке, кто на ней изображён и в каком контексте.

Задание 5. *Поиск лишней картинки*

Из четырёх изображений выберите одно, которое не подходит по смыслу к остальным. Объясните свой выбор, аргументируя, почему именно эта картинка является лишней.

Задание 6. *Диалог на основе изображений (принятие решения)*

В паре с собеседником обсудите ситуацию, представленную на картинках. Обсудите возможные варианты решения и вместе выберите наилучший. Убедительно обоснуйте свой выбор.

Задание 7. *Обсуждение и выбор решения по предложенному вопросу*

Вместе с партнёром обсудите предложенный вопрос или проблему. Обсудите разные точки зрения и варианты решений. В конце договоритесь о наиболее логичном или правильном решении и объясните, почему вы его выбрали.

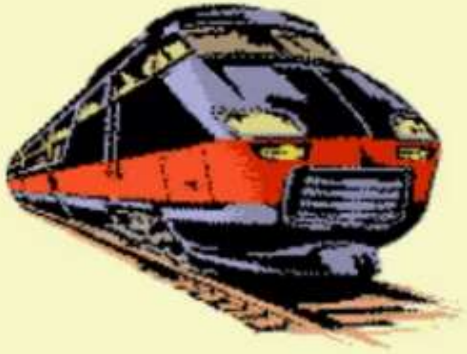

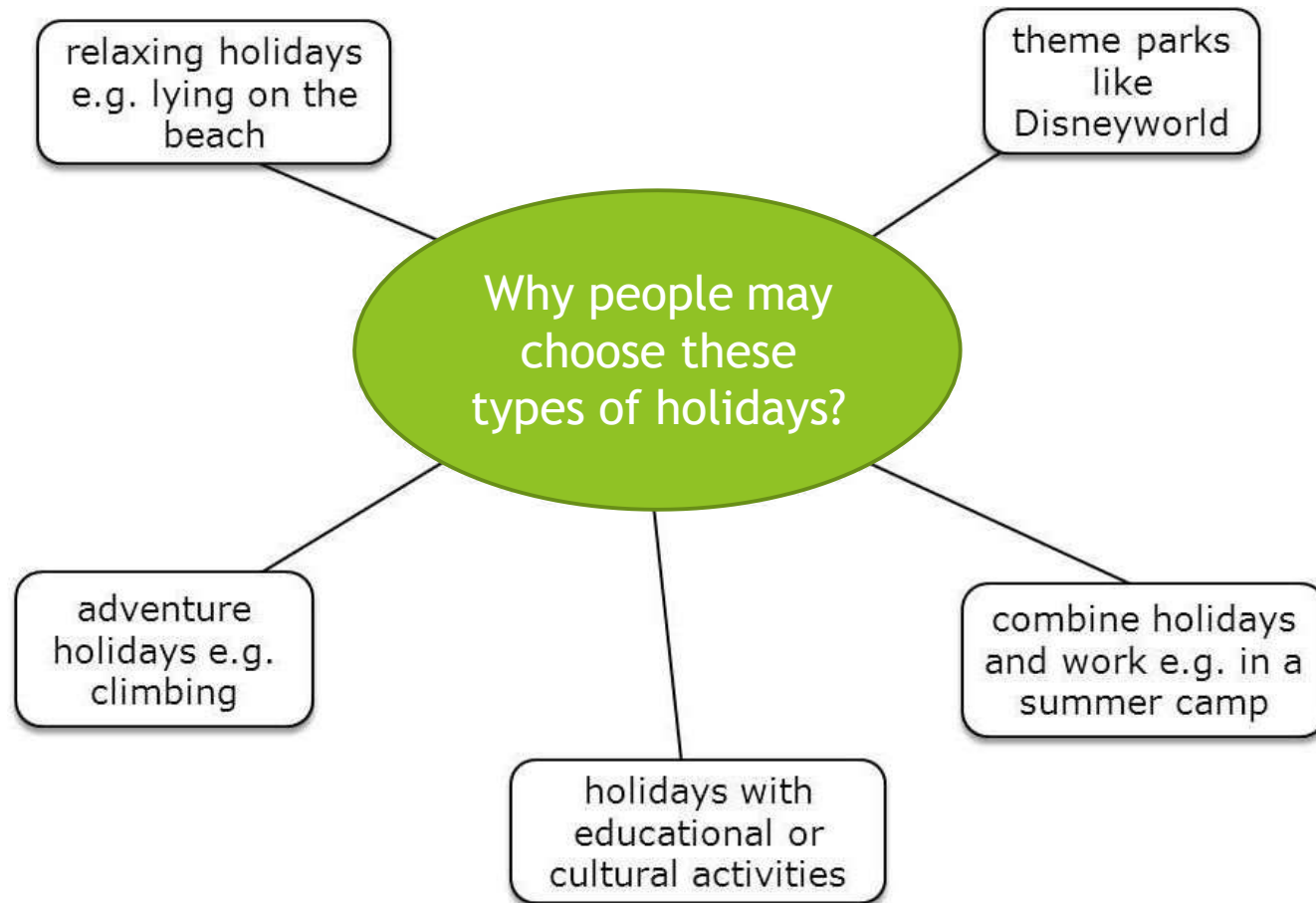
